General Description: The Director of Student Ministries should support and champion the vision of the church and actively seek to create an environment that leads and oversees the development of a comprehensive ministry to the middle school and high school students at Countryside Covenant Church.

Qualifications:

1. Possesses a faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior and possesses the call of God to Shepherd.
2. Possesses a firm foundation in the Word of God and is devoted to Scriptures for providing truth, guidance, and direction in the fulfillment of God's calling;
3. Possesses spiritual gifts, skills, and experiences that are appropriate for this calling; administration, organization, interpersonal and communication skills;
4. Demonstrates and models an authentic Christian life which is indicative of spiritual and emotional maturity;
5. Possesses a teachable spirit, team ministry mindset;
6. Is knowledgeable and supportive of the Evangelical Covenant Church and its teachings; Committed to the Affirmations of the Evangelical Covenant Church; the Mission Statement of Countryside Covenant Church and the Covenant Resolution on Human Sexuality.

Responsibilities:

1. Oversee all Middle School and High School Programing to include: Sunday Morning Christian Formation, Confirmation, and Wednesday Night programs.
2. Assist parents in developing and defining a biblical world-view for their student(s).
3. Model a healthy, balanced and spirit-filled life.
4. Recruit, lead and work closely with the Student Ministry Teams.
5. Develop evangelism, discipleship, and missional programming (CHIC, regular mission experiences, Covenant Cedars Camp, etc).
6. Oversee the training of volunteer leaders and helpers – including efforts for the development of student leadership.
7. Support students, parents, and families in crucial ways such as: spiritual growth, reconciliation, and those experiencing crisis.
8. Facilitate/Lead the student worship teams.
9. Participate in weekly staff meetings.

Education/Experience: A Bachelor's degree in Youth Ministry is preferred. Prior Student Ministry experience as a leader/volunteer is a must.
