Director of Worship in Arts

Position Title:	Director of Worship in Arts
Reports To:	Senior Pastor
Classification:	Part-time, 20 hours per week
Commitment:	The Director of Worship should have as her/his primary priority to seek a deeper, richer and abiding relationship with God in her/his personal, family and church life. He/she should pursue a purposeful life, demonstrating a personal burden for spiritual growth, time in God's Word, prayer, and commitment to her/his family. He/she will continually seek the leading of the Spirit for his/her life and worship ministry.
Personal and Professional Growth:	The director of worship should seek to grow both as a musician and as a fully devoted follower of Jesus Christ. Therefore, the director of worship is encouraged to participate in continuing education and spiritual development through conferences, seminars, workshops, lessons, etc., as available and as approved by the Leadership Team.
Ministry Responsibilities:	<p>Work with the Senior Pastor to plan worship services, including preparation of the order of worship for each service, making recommendations as needed, selecting music appropriate for sermon topics in order to create a unified spiritual experience at Sunday, as well as appropriate special events, ensuring the elements of worship are compatible with the mission statement, core values, and the vision of the church.</p> <p>Prepare and participate with worship teams in the worship service, including setting the worship team schedule based on individual availability.</p>

Model and promote a spirit of engagement that encourages the congregation's understanding of worship as participation.

Encourage the development and use of individual talents (e.g. vocalist, drama, Scripture reading, dance, etc.)

Organize and work with worship teams, other members of the congregation, and other artists as needed to coordinate seasonal and thematic elements with worship services.

Oversee the technical support ministry, which is responsible for controlling the sound system and video projections, recruiting and training the technical team, and purchasing and maintaining the equipment.

Lead in ensuring that the church is in legal compliance with music copyright laws.

Meet regularly with the Senior Pastor and worship teams to evaluate and critique worship ministries and to implement changes as necessary.

Attend staff meetings and church-sponsored events as available.

Work with the worship teams, technical support team and the Treasurer to provide input with respect to the finances required for worship, the church's annual report and budgeting process.
